One Thursday a month and some additional special dates are designated as "*Spirit Wear Day*." Students may wear clothing that displays the St. Charles logo. This includes sweatshirts, t-shirts, kindergarten/preschool t-shirt, sports jerseys, sweatpants, and nylon gym pants. St. Charles logo pajama pants are not allowed in school.

Students may wear jeans, sweat pants, running pants, or skirts along with their Spirit Wear top on Spirit Wear Days. These items must meet the out-of-uniform guidelines. If a student is not wearing Spirit Wear they are to be in uniform.
