Speaking of kicking off Advent, prepare for another packed church this Tuesday December 5th. It is the St. Charles Advent Program during the very first week of Advent, what a thrill! I know that this will help focus my mind on the coming of Christ right off the bat.

History has proven that the 3 weeks ahead of us will be intense, heart-lifting, and fast. It is a time where I always feel the closeness of our community and inspired by our work here at St. Charles. When I say "our work" I am including parents, support staff, teachers, and me too! This is our work, and these kids are our future.

I'm still looking for a couple more homes where we can place members of the NET team for the night of December 14. The details are below, and I promise that welcoming the NET team members into your home will bring grace into your life, at least for one night.

To be a host, you have to be willing to take at least two team members. They come equipped with sleeping bags so a couch, bed, or air mattress would be great. They need access to bathroom, showers, and a couple meals. The rough schedule would require picking them up on December 14 in the afternoon (at St. Charles), providing dinner that night and breakfast the following morning, and dropping them off at St. Charles on the 15th at 7:30 AM. The team supervisors receive the list of hosts when they arrive, and they place the team members based on how many can be accommodated at each site, allergies, and gender preferences (you can request male or female guests -- guests will all be either male or female).
