Ongoing Safety and Security for All

Our after school pick up has come a long way with just a hiccup here and there. Please continue to use the pick-up process and refrain from any "Stinson Blvd quick stop and jump in the car, no one will see, and it's just this once" kind of thinking.

I need your support on morning drop off. For K-8 parents, please drop students off on 27th and not on Stinson. Please do not attempt any "stop and drops" on Stinson Blvd. This will keep the bus lane clear and students safe. There is just too much car and bike traffic on Stinson to use it as a drop zone. We had a bicyclist bumped by a car attempting a stop and drop last week. We want to keep our kids safe and be good neighbors. Please follow our processes by dropping students off on 27th heading west.

If you are a preschool parent, you may park on Stinson between 7:30 AM and 2:00 PM, and then walk with your child to sign in our sign out.

On October 25th, Sergeant Huddle and the Chief of our St. Anthony police department spent an hour with our staff talking about building security, lockdown and active shooter protocols. We had a lot of really good questions for the officers, and they had a lot of good information for us. Security will continue to be a priority at St. Charles, and we will be keeping our staff and local police in close communication. On February 7, 2019, the St. Anthony PD will be conducting active shooter training in our building in the late evening after school hours. We are glad to have them conduct this training in our building so they become accustomed to how our facility is laid out.
