Max Lab Update

The Max Lab has not opened this year, and this is a short communication to explain how we'll be handling remedial support in the elementary grades at St. Charles.

Our Max Lab was historically supported through the district by federal funding called, "Title 1." Changes in the availability of this funding has lead us to re-examine how we will be supporting students who do not qualify for special services but may benefit from additional support. We gathered valuable information from the school faculty, school advisory council, and via a survey sent to parents whose children have participated in the past or may qualify this year to guide our new plan for student support.

Mrs. Sharon Rice, fourth grade classroom aide, will continue to provide aid in fourth grade. In addition, during times when the 4th graders are with a specialist or when aid support is not needed, Mrs. Rice will provide support to students with identified needs in the first – third grades. Our Kindergarten rooms are already covered with additional support from an aide (Mrs. Cecere or Miller).

The Moby Max program is available and will continue to be available to all St. Charles students to use at home. If you do not currently have a login for your child, please contact their homeroom teacher. This program is designed to assess a student's current skill level in a particular subject and provide lessons, games and assessments to move them along in that area. We have found that some parents feel this program is an effective and simple way to support their child while other parents feel like it is not the best fit for the way their child learns.

Our current class sizes at St. Charles, along with classroom aide support really do offer excellent opportunities for teachers to know and serve the kids right where they are academically. Our new plan is designed to offer some additional support, especially for learners who struggle with grade level content but do not qualify for special services.

The details for how this will look are still being worked out but the path is set! Please contact me directly with any questions.
