### 2019-20 School Enrollment is Open to the Public

Admissions for the 2019-20 school year are now open to the public. Please let your family, friends and neighbors know. All applications are completed online at this site: <a href="Maintenance">Admissions</a>

There is a non refundable tuition deposit of \$50 per child with a cap of \$100 per family required for enrollment. Please note that this is a deposit that will go toward 2019-20 tuition, and not a fee. If you wait until after February 28 to complete enrollment (including submitting required paperwork), an additional fee of \$25 per child will be added but not applied toward tuition. This fee will increase to \$50 per child on April 1.

## **Scholarship Opportunities**

The Aim Higher Foundation provides two types of scholarships for students to attend a Catholic school in the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. The application period for scholarships for the 2019-20 academic year closes February 17, 2019. We aim to award the scholarships and notify families and schools in early March.
