# Here is a very important announcement about Pick-up Procedures changing on Monday, April 1.

On Monday, April 1, (and no, this is not an April Fool's joke) we have a dismissal and pick-up change that will affect those who currently pick up on Stinson Boulevard, and those who pick up preschool students at 2:40 PM. Starting on April 1, from 2:30-3:00 PM, Stinson Boulevard will now be used for bus and preschool pick-up only. You may no longer park on the east side (school side) of Stinson Boulevard unless you are picking up a preschooler. There will be signs posted for the first couple weeks as a reminder to parents. The only vehicles

allowed to park north of the bus loading zone will be preschool parents. If you are parked there and do not have a preschool student, our preschool staff will ask that you drive around the block and pick up your child in the pick-up line which is located in the lower parking lot.

Thank you for your patience and understanding with this change as we work to keep our dismissal routine running smoothly and keep our youngest Chargers safe!
