Parents, students, educators, the Senate Majority Leader, and the bill's author were featured. Momentum is building to help make a positive difference for Minnesota students.

As you know, opportunity scholarships will help families send their children to the school that is the best fit for them. No child should be denied a good education because of their ZIP code or their family's financial situation.
