Dear St. Charles Parents,

The first weeks of school have flown by, and the foundation for a great year is being built. The first thing I want to mention is that fall NWEA MAP testing will begin next week. The students in grades 2-8 take math, language arts, and reading tests. The students in grades K-1 only take the math and reading tests. Each test has 42-52 questions, and they take approximately 50 minutes to complete, although they are not timed.

In the past, we have only tested in the fall and spring even though NWEA offers the option to take a winter test. This year, mainly due to teacher requests, we are considering the winter test. The fall tests give our teachers a good sense of student strengths and weaknesses as well as class-wide strengths and weaknesses. By the time December and January roll around, that fall data is no longer accurate, and the teachers would like to see a fresh inventory. It lets them know where their efforts have been effective and helps them identify areas that still need attention. More to come as we look into this.

Today we had our first NPH Day of the year, and it was a success. For new families, I apologize for not giving you more of a preview of this school project. Nuestros Pequenos Hermanos (NPH) means "our little brothers and sisters." There are about ten large orphanages across Mexico and Central America that care for kids who have lost their parents or whose families cannot provide for them. Each month, we celebrate the relationship and sponsorship of nine children (one for each K-8 grade level) who live at the Honduras NPH "ranch." The celebration includes wearing Spirit Wear or orange (NPH uniform color), bringing a \$1 donation (students may bring more if they wish), and praying for these students. We are assured that as a part of this relationship, the prayers are also coming from Honduras for St. Charles. We did not receive letters last year from the kids due to a paperwork mishap, but we will receive them this year and plan to write back.
