# 2020-21 School Enrollment for Current Students and Parishioners Is Open through Wednesday, January 14

Online enrollment for current students and parishioners is now open. An individualized email was sent to each family yesterday to access your family's specific enrollment link, or you may log in to your TADS account to start the process. The website is <a href="https://secure.tads.com/">https://secure.tads.com/</a>. To sign in to your account, you will need your email and password. If you do not know your password, click on the "Forgot your password?" prompt on the TADS website.

There is a non refundable tuition deposit of \$50 per child with a cap of \$100 per family required for enrollment. This is a deposit that will go toward tuition, and not a fee. Now through February 29, there is a \$25 per student enrollment fee. From March 1-31, the enrollment fee is \$25 per student. This fee will increase to \$75 per student on April 1 and to \$100 per student on May 1.
