Dear St. Charles Parents,

The "24-hour rule" is a window of health while your child is recovering that ensures they are safe to return to school and will not infect other students. If your child is vomiting, and the last time they vomit is 10:00 AM on Tuesday, the earliest they may return to school is 10:01 on Wednesday. The same rule applies for a fever. If your child's fever breaks at 1:00 PM on Wednesday, the earliest they may return to school is 10:01 on Wednesday. The same rule applies for a fever. If your child comes to school inside of this window, and we are aware of it, we will call you to pick them up until they are in compliance. Thank you for your attention to this. In addition, President's Day weekend is a great time to clean their belongings to make sure that no illness is following them around. Enjoy the long weekend!
