If you didn't catch the principal's email earlier today, here it is:

Dear St. Charles Parents,

We continue to watch and monitor the progress of the COVID-19 virus. We are in touch with our diocesan leadership as well as our local public school district. As we prepare for a much-anticipated spring break, we will also be taking certain steps to ensure safety and learning in the weeks ahead.

Our plan is to return from spring break on March 23 as scheduled, but, for the safety of staff, students, and our families, we want to be prepared for the scenario that we move into a closure. Students will be bringing home textbooks today and tomorrow that we want them to have at home for break in case we need to move to "at-home learning" on March 23rd. Teachers will not be assigning work over spring break.

Students in grades K-4 will be bringing home a piece of paper with their Moby Max login information on it. This program can be a helpful skill builder at any time. If we move to online learning, teachers may choose to use this program to assign lessons or practice that students can complete at home. K-4 students will also bring home their ConnectED login information in case you don't have it readily available. In grades 5-8, students may receive work directly from their Gmail accounts. All of our teachers will continue to communicate with parents of students through Google Group emails.

Please contact your child's teacher if access to the internet, a computer, or a printer will be difficult for your family.

Our intention here is not to create alarm but to be prepared and prudent in how we approach this situation. If your family will be traveling over spring break, out of state, or out of the country, please email the office through the school's main account to tell us where you will be traveling.

We will continue to provide you with updates and communication over spring break this year.
