Dear St. Charles Parents.

As we begin the summer, I have just a few things to update you on. There are many questions about what the fall will look like, and I want you to know that Fr. Przybilla and I are behind Bishop Cozzens's commitment to have Catholic schools open this fall. There are questions about what practices and equipment we will need to meet the guidelines for opening, there are questions about what the guidelines will be, and there are questions about what the comfort levels of our families will be in regard to returning to school. We do know that this virus has rarely proven to be dangerous to youngsters, but there is concern about the spread of the virus from young people who come into contact with those who may be at risk. To give us a sense of where our families are about returning to school, we will be releasing 2-3 surveys this summer. We are doing this more than once because we understand circumstances and feelings can change between now and the first day of school and your input helps us plan for the year ahead. Look for the first survey during the month of June.

We are still in the process of finalizing our annual calendar for the upcoming school year. I do apologize that we don't have this for you yet and promise to send it out next week.

This year we were not able to hold our Borromeo Bash as we have in previous years. This event has always been a great celebration of community and fellowship as well as a successful fundraiser for our school. I really feel our community is missing the opportunity to get together, celebrate, and bond. Unfortunately, not much can be done about that at this point. We look forward to opportunities like this in the year ahead.

In place of the fundraising that we do at the Borromeo Bash, we will be running a summer appeal for our beloved school. We realize that the crises we've experienced in recent times have left many families in difficult financial positions. Our hope is to raise about \$20,000 allowing us to keep our Gary Wilmer scholarship funds healthy, purchase all of the new social studies resources, and give our community the opportunity to support our school. To maximize our efforts, I've applied for a grant from CSCOE that would match our donations up to \$11,250. These funds would be dedicated to providing scholarship money for families and maintaining or even increasing enrollment. This is per the requirements of the grant. We have experienced an increase in financial need from our families and anticipate there may be more coming over this summer. Next week, I'll have an update on the grant application and more details about this summer appeal.

This weekend, on Corpus Christi Sunday, our 2nd graders receive the gift of First Communion! They've been preparing for this all year. They are very excited, and we are very proud of them. I'd like to acknowledge Anne

Flynn and Laura Bilski for leading our kids through this process. Please keep all of our First Communicants and their catechists in your prayers.
