


SCHOOL MARATHON INFORMATION Saturday, October 3rd, 2020

Please join us **VIRTUALLY** and **LIVE** on the St. Charles Facebook page for the St. Charles School Marathon, a day of service and reflection!

MARATHON GOAL

- The Marathon is the most important school fundraising event of the year.
- All donations go directly to our school's operating budget to support various programs.
- The Marathon is also a community-building event that helps raise awareness of non-public education.



FUNDRAISING

- We are asking each student in Kindergarten through 8th grade to meet a minimum fundraising goal of \$185.
- Students in preschool and pre-kindergarten are also invited to participate.

- Students may ask relatives, neighbors, friends and co-workers, to sponsor them for participating. Families may also choose to make the fair share payment of \$185 per student.
- Matching Funds Programs are offered for educational institutions by many companies. They can be a *huge* help in reaching our goal. Please check with your employer about any matching fund programs that may be offered.



SERVICE PROJECT

This year we are adding a voluntary service project to the Marathon. This can be a meaningful activity for students to participate in and gather Marathon pledges for.

- The service project can be completed before or on the Marathon day.
- The school wil not lead, monitor or pre-approve service projects.
- Please wear your SPIRIT WEAR or anything GREEN to show your Charger Pride during your service project.
- Take a photo of your work and send it in for a chance to win a bike! (Check the Resources & Contact section below for where to send your photo.)
- Service project photos may be displayed during the family rosary.
- Service projects may include:
 - Crafting cards for isolated or elderly people
 - Raking leaves
 - Washing cars
 - Making lunches / boxing food for homeless shelters or those in need
 - Create your own!



PRIZES & INCENTIVES:

In addition to supporting our school through fundraising, students <u>have a chance</u> to win prizes and earn incentives. Prize drawings will be held every Friday up until the Marathon day.

EVERYONE

 All students will be entered into weekly prize drawings for their efforts in working towards the school goal.

INDIVIDUAL

 Students who have collected \$185 or more by the day of the Marathon will be entered into drawings for grand prizes given out on the Marathon day during the 9am Facebook LIVE. Students who have turned in a photo of their service project either before or on the day of the day of the Marathon will be entered into a drawing for one bike gift certificate from CARS Bike Shop. This will be drawn on the day of the Marathon during the 7pm Facebook LIVE. (Check the Resources & Contact section below for where to send your photo.)



PRAYER INTENTIONS

Prayer intention slips are for anyone to fill out. These voluntary slips are included in the packet with an example dialogue.

- Prayer intentions slips can be turned into the school office at any time before the Marathon day.
- A donation is NOT required for a prayer intention slip to be filled out.
- These intentions may be read on the Marathon day during the family rosary and/or placed before the Blessed Sacrament during adoration.



TURNING IN DONATIONS

<u>Please do not turn in donations to the school office until ALL of your donations have been collected.</u> If you are donating through TADS or online, you do not need to return the sponsor log or envelope.

- <u>TADS:</u> You can now make your families' contribution to the Marathon via TADS. If you are interested in this option, please contact Angela Bollensen to arrange.
