Dear St. Charles Parents,

Another weekly update and another week almost in the books. As we move through this year, the interruptions that we anticipated are becoming real. We have a higher volume of students out because they have symptoms. This number is increased due to the practice of keeping siblings home if a child has 2 less common symptoms or 1 of the common symptoms. The teachers and I are working to improve our plans and practice of serving kids who are out. This is not easy because of the continuous flow. We will continue to work to make things better. We appreciate your patience. All in all, I'm very happy with how things are going.

I need to ask that parents, grandparents, and friends not attempt to visit kids on our playground. Our students' safety is important, and we want to make every effort to maintain safe practices. A tricky thing in Catholic communities is that we think, "This is my community and people know me. I am a safe person, so this is ok." The problem is this creates a loophole in our plan for safety. If I tell the playground supervisors to keep outsiders from interacting with our kids unless we know them, it weakens our plan. I've instructed playground supervisors to approach anyone who attempts to interact with our students on the playground to let them know that we're not allowing personnel outside of our staff and student body to interact with our students while they are under our care. Your cooperation is appreciated!
