Dear St. Charles Parents,

I know that many are wondering how some of the recent MDH guideline changes to quarantine time will impact our practices. As it sits right now, we are not making any changes for a couple of reasons. One reason is that MDH has not updated the decision tree for schools as of yet. This tool helps schools and youth programs make decisions about how to proceed, and MDH has not changed the quarantine times on this document. Another reason is that we are not able to meet the criteria specified for shortening quarantine time. The communication states that the 14-day exposure quarantine is the safest and is still recommended. It goes on to say, "You may consider being around others 10 days after exposure if:

- -There are no symptoms
- -There has not been a positive test

-The person wears a mask and stays at least 6 feet away from other people."

As our preparedness plan states, students are seated in the classroom at least three feet from one another with greater distance if possible. In our school and classrooms, we cannot manage much more than three feet, we just don't have space. Since we cannot meet the six feet criteria for the shorter exposure quarantine option, we will not be adopting this as a practice. We will continue to watch for updates from MDH and CDC. There has been an uptick in students with symptoms, exposures, and positive cases in the past couple of weeks. Please remain diligent in your personal lives practicing safe distancing, mask wearing, hand washing, and avoiding larger gatherings, especially indoors. This is our best hope to continue in-person learning.

Just a reminder that **the whole school will be distance learning January 4-8** as previously communicated. We believe that this will help us, in the long run, to continue in-person learning. Please see the opportunity below to receive food during this period of time. I really encourage our families to take advantage of this program. There is an abundance of food going out to help families, and it is not just families who have great needs.

Before signing off, I'd just like to let parents know that during this surge we are increasing our urge for parents to have kids tested, even in the case of a single symptom, as recommended by MDH. Please bear with us through this period where the infection rates are the highest. If your child has one symptom, please strongly consider keeping them home and having them tested. If they show up at school with a symptom, even if it is a less common one, we will likely be in touch with you. We are beginning to feel the heat here, and we need your support in keeping our staff, students, and community safe. Here is a link to the MDH testing sites: locations/community-testing.

#### Free Lunch Program for Distance Learners

The Roseville Nutrition Program provides the St Charles school lunch program. When students are doing distance learning, we have been informed that the Roseville Nutrition Program offers weekly meal bundles for students during that time. Students receive meal bundles that contain five days' worth of breakfast, lunch, and snacks as well as milk. Special diets (allergies, celiac) and vegetarian preferences can be accommodated. Entrees are made in the program's kitchens and served in microwavable containers.

Meals are available for pickup at St Anthony Village High School and at Wilshire Park Elementary School. If you are interested in meals at any time your child is distance learning, sign up <u>here</u>. Keep this in mind for January 4-8 when everyone will be distance learning. Meals may be picked up on Mondays from 4:00-6:00 at St Anthony Village High School. They may also be picked up from 1:00-3:00 on Tuesdays and Thursdays at either Wilshire Park Elementary (door 15) or St Anthony Village High School (door 16). For those unable to pick up meals, there is a Wednesday delivery option.
