Dear St. Charles Parents,

Starting tomorrow at the end of the school day, our bus will be arriving earlier; this will last through the end of the year. This means a few things:

- 1. We need our **preschool parents to park ahead of the bus lane when picking up in the afternoon** as the signage on Stinson indicates.
- 2. We need **K-8 parents to use the pick-up line for picking up kids and not park on Stinson Blvd.** Please take note and follow these directions for a smooth pick up.

K-8 parents need to use the pick up line to pick up their kids at the end of the day. It is the safest way, and it runs smoothly 95% of the time. The line is always finished by 3:00PM. If you show up at 2:50 PM, you'll run right through with hardly any delay. **If you are picking your kids up, please use the pick-up line.**

During the cold snap we made some adjustments so the students could still have mask breaks. Mask breaks in sub-zero temperatures are rather unpleasant. The adjustment was to have kids put up their trifold clear barriers, sit in their chairs, and crank up the air purifiers even higher while they took mask breaks at their seats. As of today, we are back to outdoor breaks which is a very welcome return! I'm communicating this because I said I

would communicate when making adjustments to the plan. This communication should have come earlier. I take responsibility for that. This is what we will do in the future if we hit sub-zero temperatures again or have some other circumstance preventing outdoor mask breaks.

Ash Wednesday went really well. This was the closest thing to an all-school Mass that we've had this year, and it was special. During Lent we are able to give all of our K-8 students the chance to participate in Stations of the Cross on Wednesdays (K-4) and Fridays (5-8) at 2:00PM. Fr. Przybilla and Deacon Najarian have been gracious enough to offer the stations twice so that all of our students can participate just like in other years.

Next week the basketball portion of the Sue McSherry & Liz Hickman Basketball Blast will be going on at St. Charles. On Monday, all students will be able to come out of uniform with a suggested donation of \$1 or more. All donations will go to Make A Wish or the Sue McSherry Scholarship Fund. Students in grades 4-8 have the opportunity to participate in basketball activities after school next week on designated days. Please see below for the schedule of when each grade level will be participating. There is also a permission slip that all 4th grade participants must have signed. Students in grades 5-8 who have not previously turned in a permission slip for after school basketball must also turn in a signed permission slip.

Parenting with Executive Functioning Skills in Mind: Strategies to Build Skill

Many children procrastinate, lack organization, have emotional outbursts, get "stuck" in their worries, are poor planners, or demonstrate other Executive Functioning difficulties. If your child frequently struggles in these areas, it might be impacting his/her school or social success. During this talk, parents will learn about the role of Executive Functioning in child and adolescent development. They will better understand the areas of Executive Functioning and take away simple, concrete parenting strategies to help their children develop lagging skills.
