Help your Struggling Learner ~ March 10, 7:00 PM or March 22, 7:00 PM

When our children struggle in school, it is hard to know when to be firm and when to be flexible. Should we intervene early and structure the environment for success, or should we view learning as developmental and expect all of our children to advance at different speeds? Should we give our kids consequences for poor grades, or can we "pay" them to get A's? How do we know when poor school achievement is something more serious than low motivation? In this session, you will learn research-based strategies for helping struggling learners no matter the cause of the struggle.
