### Dear St. Charles Parents,

We're nearing the end of another very full week, even with a day without students on Tuesday! Looking back, our 8th graders were confirmed at a beautiful Mass last Sunday led by Archbishop Hebda, Fr. Przybilla, and Deacon Najarian. Mr. Hartnett and Mr. Wagenbach did a beautiful job preparing them for the sacrament, and we look forward to their contributions to our local and global church. This Sunday, our 2nd graders will be receiving First Communion at St. Charles Borromeo Church. We are grateful to Mrs. Juntilla and Mrs. Flynn for their efforts in preparing our 2nd graders for this beloved sacrament. Please keep all of our students receiving sacraments and their teachers in your prayers!

NWEA MAP testing will begin next week and be complete by May 7th. Spring MAP testing is always a sign that the end of the school year is coming soon! Your child(ren)'s teachers will be in touch with you about when this testing will take place. Please do your best to have students in school on time and in attendance every day. We realize that we are in a time that students who have symptoms need to stay out of school. Please continue to honor this. If your child is out with symptoms, an exposure, or positive test, we will work out a way for them to complete the tests. Our students in grade 2-8 take reading, language, and math tests that each take about 1 hour to complete. Our students in K-1 take reading and math tests that each take about one hour to complete. I often receive the question, "Is this the MCA state testing?" The answer is "no,it is not." St. Charles does not

participate in the state testing. We determined some years ago that NWEA is the best and most effective way to assess our students' growth without cutting into too much instructional time.

Last week, I said that we would be surveying our parents and staff about their experiences this year and hopes for the future. I hope to launch these surveys during the first week of May which is right around the corner. There are a few things that I'm giving priority right now, and I believe that the priority is prudent. It is hiring season, and I am pursuing the best candidates to replace St. Charles staff and faculty who are moving on at the end of this year. It is also budget and work agreement season, so we are working on a preliminary budget for the year ahead to be approved by the finance council. In addition, we are also working on the application for our EANS grant from the federal government. This grant was passed down from the federal government to the state providing 41 million dollars for Minnesota non-public schools. At St. Charles, we are applying for this grant that will very likely provide substantial financial relief and support to our school. Finally, as I mention, we're preparing to administer the spring NWEA testing.

I had the chance to speak to a number of parents, and the conversations and feedback have been mostly positive and constructive. I look forward to gaining more perspective during the month of May as we reflect on the year behind us and set our eyes on the year ahead.
