This Tuesday, May 4, Bishop Cozzens will be paying a visit to St. Charles. We are excited to welcome Bishop Cozzens to our school to pray with our students and celebrate Mass. The visit will begin with a visit to each of our K-3 classrooms for some time to connect with our students, pray, and give a blessing. After that, Bishop Cozzens will celebrate Mass with our 4th-8th grade students in our church. We are looking forward to this occasion and feel blessed to have another opportunity to connect with one of our local bishops.

MAP testing is underway and will be complete by May 7. It is always a challenge to motivate students to take the test seriously in the spring; this year is no exception, and it may be even more challenging!

We are trying something new to motivate students to do their best on their MAP test by giving away some prizes. We contemplated gift cards but had a hard time settling on a card that would be interesting to all students. We settled on one that is green with a picture of Abraham Lincoln on it. You guessed it. Everyone knows what to do with a \$5 bill. There will be a top score prize for each test at each grade level and a most growth prize for each test at each grade level. Students who are high achievers have the best shots at winning the top score prizes and students who generally perform on or below grade level will have the best shots at winning the most growth prizes. Each student can only win one prize at their grade level. Other prizes will go to the next best score or margin of growth. Every student has a shot at these prizes. But wait, there's more! Each grade level is working as a team to hit the grade level of projected growth for each test, and if they do this, they will earn a movie afternoon during the month of May. This will probably be scheduled on a rainy afternoon. ;-) What we reinforce with our students is that we just want them to give us their best effort so that we can capture an accurate measurement of their growth this year.

This week has been filled with interviews to fill the positions of teachers moving on at the end of this school year. I'm very pleased to share that we are attracting excellent candidates who are passionate about Catholic education and who are highly qualified. Tomorrow, I'm going to begin drafting the staff and parent surveys I mentioned earlier. I hope to be launching them by the end of next week.

St. Charles parents, the sun is back, and we are on the verge of the month of May, the fastest month of the year. Please partner with us in making this month great for our kids! We want to finish strong and finish with some fun. Your cooperation and partnership has pulled us through the year this far, and we will continue to rely on and appreciate your support.
