Here are a couple of housekeeping items I need your attention on:

- 1. When entering the end of the day pick-up line, please do not enter through the alley between Pahl and 27th. Turn onto Roosevelt from 27th.
- 2. In the morning between 7:20-7:40, we need to keep the bus lane in front of the school open so the buses can park and let our kids out. Please do not park in the bus lane in the morning

Andrew Wagenbach and Jacob Nelson have organized two opportunities for you, our St. Charles parents, to attend a retreat. A flyer went out earlier this week about these opportunities (October 9 & 16). Find the <u>flyer</u> <u>here</u>. Parenting is not an easy vocation, and these are certainly challenging times. This retreat will provide formation for you to support the formation of your household. Your households are the fiber of our community, so please know that I want you to do this!

Conference sign-up is now live; we look forward to meeting with you in a couple of weeks. You received an email earlier this week with a link to secure your spot during conferences on October 18 and 19. More details below.

Marathon season is going well! We are up to \$49,818.00 which is striking distance of our \$55,000 goal. As of today, 68% of our students have participated in this year's marathon by bringing in sponsorship dollars and 59% of our students have reached their goal. Let's see if we can get those percentages up! The last day of collecting Marathon money that counts toward prizes will be Wednesday, October 13 of the week ahead. We'll have a

closing assembly on Friday, October 15 to announce totals, give out prizes, and announce rewards for grade-level and school-wide goals.

This last paragraph is dedicated to communicating a difficult situation. Today I received notice from our food service that they will need to cancel our contract as of November 5, 2021 of this school year. The cancellation is due to a shortage they have in staffing and the need to re-assign the personnel working at St. Charles to address other shortages in the district. This is a last resort for them, and they are very sad about it. This is disappointing and very difficult for us. I will begin looking for other potential vendors to run our lunch program here at St. Charles. Another possibility would be to provide the Roseville District Food Program with two candidates that they could hire, train, and put to work here at St. Charles. If you know of any candidates who may be interested in this, please contact me right away. I know that this is distressing for families that rely on our lunch program to feed their children each day. Please know that I will do my best to resolve this situation.

- Preschool conferences will be scheduled in 15 minutes time slots with your child's teacher.
- Grade K-4 conferences will be scheduled in 20 minute time slots with your child's teacher.
- For Middle School conferences, you will register for one-hour slots. During your hour, you may
 visit any middle school teacher in any order. If the line is long for a teacher, you may choose to
 visit another while the line shortens. Please introduce yourself and let each teacher know your
 child's name when you sit down. Middle school grade level teacher lists will be provided in the
 cafeteria on conference nights. Please note, there are places to select conference times for
 MS, an early one and a late one.
