#### Dear St. Charles Parents,

We are having issues with our buses being able to drop kids off in the morning. This is leading to unsafe situations and backing up traffic on Stinson Blvd. We need our parents to keep the bus lane open so that buses can park in front of the school in the morning. Please give this notice your attention and don't park in front of the school in the morning.

Fall conferences are next week. If you have not signed up to meet with your child's teacher, please do that right away! This is a very important night for the partnership between parents and teachers. Our kids benefit so much from this night, and the irony is that they don't even show up! When our parents, teachers, & staff work together, the students succeed whether they like it or not;-)

The Parent Retreat part 2 is this Saturday; please see the <u>flyer</u> for more information. This part 2 is not a sequel nor does it build off of last week's retreat. This is a repeat retreat in case you could not make it last week. However, they have been through it once already, so this week's retreat will be even better! I hope to see you there.

This is the part where I talk about COVID-19, so if you are tired of hearing about COVID-19, you can stop reading;-) Over last weekend, we had 4 students test positive for COVID-19 in Pre-K, Grade 3, Grade 5 & Grade 7. In all these cases, transmission happened in the household, not school. We quarantined a number of students from these grade levels according to students we determined were in close contact. Two additional students tested positive this week; they were close contacts who were out on quarantine, so no additional action is

needed here at school. We do believe that these 2 new cases were transmissions that took place at school or in our athletics programs. Additionally, we had a 1st grade student who tested positive from a household exposure; this student was not in school during the infectious period, so no action is needed here at school.

Preventing transmissions in the building by keeping our kids home when they are sick and requiring quarantine times for students who are positive or close contact is part of our commitment to slow the spread of the virus. We make this effort to keep the need for medical attention manageable for our health care workers and hospitals. We are aware that the measures we are taking at St. Charles will not stop COVID-19. Fr. Przybilla and I share the perspective that we have a responsibility in our local community to make an effort to slow the spread so that those in need of medical assistance, for whatever reason, can receive it.
