Dear St. Charles Parents.

I have a lot to tell you today, so I'll cut down on the fluff and get to the point.

Tomorrow, after 8:00 AM Mass, we'll be praying and releasing the balloon rosary in the parking lot. It will probably be between 8:45 AM-9:00 AM. During the month of October, we honor Mary's role in the life of Jesus Christ, and this is a small celebration to end the month. Parents are welcome to join us for Mass and/or the balloon rosary afterward.

Monday is All Saints Day, and our 1st graders will be dressing up as saints and processing in at the 8:00 AM Mass. Afterwards they will be doing an All Saints parade through the school singing out the Litany of Saints while they walk. This is a long-time St. Charles tradition that we missed out on last year.

We have a new provider for our nutrition program that will be starting at St. Charles on November 8. We are very happy to have an agreement with CKC foods to serve lunch to our students and staff for the remainder of this year. Next week will be the last week that our students will be served by the Roseville School Nutrition Program. The menu for next week is here. We will send out the menu for the rest of November when it is finalized.

Since hot lunch for all students is still being paid for by the state this year, there will not be a need to switch lunch accounts for our families. Families that have a balance on their lunch account will receive a refund check from the Roseville School Nutrition Program during the month of November. Thank you for your prayers and support throughout this process. We had many parents contact us with ideas and help to secure a new hot lunch provider. Lunch program - Check!

Speaking of lunch, we will be moving back to having all of our students dine in the cafeteria next week. We have moved the tent to the parish side and taken down the outdoor lunchroom tables. Grades K-3 will be eating together and grades 4-8 will be eating together. Our cafeteria has enough tables for each child to have their own bench. We knew that we would not be able to offer outdoor lunch forever, and the time has come. If all of the students are present, there are approximately 140 students in the 4-8 lunch period and 130 in the K-3 lunch period.

The celebration of Eucharistic Days in our parish is coming the weekend of November 5-7. Our students will have the opportunity to attend First Friday Adoration on the 5th. There will be events throughout the weekend for families. Check the <u>flier</u> for all the happenings of the weekend.

Thanks for reading what I have to say today! Things are good here at St. Charles. Thank you for showing up for conferences last week! It was great to have so many positive connections between parents and teachers.
