Dear St. Charles Parents,

There is a lot to say since I didn't say much last week, and there is a lot happening here at the school we love so well. Last week, we had the return of our K-4 Advent program which was beautiful, just like it is every year. I would call it a shot in the arm for our community – a shot full of joy, hope, and the Holy Spirit. Mr. Vanderwall (our K-4 music teacher) along with our 4th grade teachers Mrs. Gasik and Ms. Bauer (who handled production of the service for their first time) did a magnificent job. We were able to show off our talented staff by having Mrs. Manciu, Mrs. Seashore, and Ms. Kolasa helping to lead the music. Of course, every parent swelled with pride for their child that evening. From where I sat, every child felt like a star and performed like one.

The staff at St. Charles enjoyed a festive and delicious lunch spread last Friday. They actually sat down for a full 45 minute lunch during a school day! This was made possible by parents who came in to volunteer as playground supervisors, parents who came in to set up the lunch, parents who served the lunch, and parents who cleaned up when all was said and done. Tonight is our Christmas Band and Choir Concert that will be taking place in the gymnasium this year. Choir will begin performing at 6:00PM, and the band goes on at 7:00 PM. the gym you'll see about 100 chairs on the floor and the bleachers will be out as well. The kids have been rehearsing since September, and the show is a sure hit! Be sure to enjoy the artwork in the corridor on your way to the gym!

When we return from Christmas break, we will hit enrollment season for 2022-2023 right away. Priority enrollment for parishioners and current families will begin on January 5 and go through January 11. **Please take time to handle your enrollment for the 2022-23 school year during this priority time set aside just for you.** Information about tuition for next year will go out next week along with reminders about Preschool Parent Information Night and Kindergarten Round-Up. Kindergarten Round-Up is Tuesday, January 11, and Preschool Parent Information Night is Thursday, January 13.

Here at St. Charles, our enrollment has gone up each year for the last 6 years. We still have room in our classrooms at every grade level to expand our family.
