Dear St. Charles Parents,

This Sunday our 8th graders will be confirmed at the Cathedral of St. Paul! Please keep them in your prayers over the weekend as they take this step in their faith journey.

I'm happy to say that we had over 200 submissions for our homework survey. We'll be using this data to support our review of homework practices at St. Charles.

Today, I would like to ask for your help with drop-off and pick-up time. We are running into congestion and safety issues because some parents are not following the procedures we have in place. Deviating from the procedure may save a person a few minutes, but overall, it contributes to breakdowns and compromise of safety for the community.

In the morning, please drop students off on 27th Avenue heading west so that your child(ren) may exit the passenger side right on to the sidewalk. Parents may drop students off on Stinson before the bus lane begins; there should be no parking in this area, and the drop off should be swift with students exiting the passenger side. There should be no parking or drop off in the bus lane directly in front of the school in the morning or afternoon. The bus lane is marked by signs. It is very important that our buses are able to get in and out without being held up or having to stop in other places. <u>Please keep the bus lane in front of the school clear</u>. Ahead of the bus lane there is a preschool parking area designated for preschool parents to park and walk their child up to the door.

At the end of the day we need all parents who are picking their child(ren) up to use the pick up-line. Each day, the pick up is "wait-free" by 2:50. It takes less than 10 minutes if you arrive at 2:40, if you arrive at 2:45 you'll be on your way in 5 minutes. Parents may choose to park, legally, in the neighborhood on the street, walk up, and pick up their child on foot as well. Thank you for your attention and cooperation to these matters.

Next week we will be teaching our OPCY lessons for child safety. These lessons are designed to help students learn how to live in a way that keeps them safe from potential predators out in the world and online. When I was a child we had "Officer Friendly" who taught these lessons. At St. Charles, we have our awesome religion teachers and NetSmartz curriculum to help us teach these lessons. The internet has certainly expanded and shaped how we teach this type of safety now.
