Dear St. Charles Families,

I have a few really important things to communicate with you today. One important announcement is that we won't be in session on January 2nd, which is when New Year's Day is observed this year. We originally had this scheduled as our day to return from Christmas break, but after consulting with some other schools and consideration, our students will not be in session that day. Our calendar has been updated, and we will resume school on January 3rd.

The level of illness has been high in schools in our area this year. We have been pretty fortunate so far, but in the last couple of weeks, our luck has run out. We've had students out ill in the range of 30-55 students a day. Faculty has been hit to the point of me teaching classes! I have an administrator's license, but my teaching license has expired, and the kids seem to be able to tell. ;-)

I mention the increase in illness to underscore the need to practice wellness, to keep our kids home when they are not well, and to do our part to curb the level of illness in the building. This wave of sickness was bound to happen, and it will continue. Our collective efforts won't stop it completely, but they will help to keep more kids in chairs and more teachers in front of the classroom. Please practice prudence!

This wave of absences right at the end of the trimester makes things difficult to finalize grades. In some cases, a teacher may communicate with parents about a report card being delayed or a student may receive an "Incomplete" represented by the letter, "I."
