Dear St. Charles Families.

Enrollment season is here, and if you have not enrolled your children for next year, I suggest you do that today. If you get this done by Wednesday, January 18 at high noon you will be entered in a drawing for three \$200 tuition vouchers and 5 Eagle's Nest tickets!

I have a topic related to enrollment that our pastor Fr. Przybilla asked me to bring to you. When you enroll, you'll notice that there is tuition for parishioners and tuition for non-parishioners. There is not a huge difference between the two, but the difference is an acknowledgement of the support we receive from our parishioners through the parish. The parish provides the school with \$250,000-\$300,000 dollars each year to offset the cost of tuition through maintenance and cash subsidy. They do this because they believe in the work we are doing, our mission, and making a Catholic education available to all who desire it. Our parishioners financially support the parish through weekly offerings and the parish support comes to the school. This is the reason for the difference in tuition rates.

What does it mean to be a parishioner? If you are selecting the St. Charles parishioner rate, it means that you are a registered member of the parish, attend Sunday Mass regularly, and participate in the Sacramental life of the church. It also means that you contribute to the parish through weekly offerings or tithing, support parish life by volunteering when you are able, and participating in events. I'm clarifying this because the selection of parishioner tuition is on each family's honor, and I want you to know what it means to select this option with integrity. Please contact me or our pastor with any questions on this topic.

In the week ahead, we will have Kindergarten Round Up on Tuesday and Preschool Information Night for Parents on Thursday. There are details in the Weekly Update below, and if you have a child who is eligible for one of these grade levels, you received an email about it. Please share these events with your friends and family who may have interest in St. Charles School.

I have an important morning drop-off announcement. Our buses need to be able to park in the bus lane to drop off students in the morning. We have six buses that drop off. Do not park in the bus lane in front of the school. The buses have been double parking on Stinson to drop off students. This is not safe, and it is very disruptive to traffic on Stinson. Thank you for your attention to this matter by not parking in the "No Parking" bus zone in front of our school.

There will be exciting news in the weeks to come with Catholic Schools Week approaching. Stay tuned for the most exciting season of the year!
