Dear St. Charles Families,

This week is a week of striving for normalcy, a return to our routines and schedules. Catholic Schools Week was great this year, and we were fortunate to cap off the week with a very well attended and successful Liz Hickman/Sue McSherry Basketball Blast Fundraiser.

I would also like to thank all the parents who contributed to the fun and helped out with extra projects. And finally, thank you to the rest of the faculty and staff who worked extra hours to make the celebration of our Catholic school fun and meaningful.

Parents who are considering applying for financial assistance for the 2023-2324 school year must apply for financial assistance by February 22nd to be considered for the Aim Higher Scholarships. Completing this application as soon as possible puts you in the best position to receive assistance from St. Charles or Aim

Higher. They increase the number of Aim Higher scholarships available each year. These applications are taken from TADS, so applying for financial assistance from St. Charles makes you eligible for Aim Higher grants. Families currently receiving AIM Higher funds must reapply each year in order for the award to continue from year to year. Financial assistance is something our community commits to providing for families in need. There are limits to the amount of aid that we can give out each year, so please give prayerful discernment to the amount of aid you request. It is our nature as human beings to see what we can get. With Catholic education, I ask that you consider the question, "How much do we need?"

In the week ahead, the Sisters of Life are going to visit our students for an hour on Monday. I'm excited to have women in religious life speak to our kids about their lives and mission. On Wednesday, the 5th-8th graders will be doing the Biz Town simulation. This is a Junior Achievement field trip that teaches basic economics, finance, and commerce. It's like the students get a day in the life of a simulated grown-up world.

Friday is a staff workshop day and Monday is Presidents Day, so there will be no school for students on Friday the 17th and Monday the 20th. Enjoy the four day weekend!
