Dear St. Charles Families.

Looking ahead, we have Charlie Maguire coming as an artist in residence at our school beginning Monday! He'll visit each K-8 grade level five times over the three week residency and each K-8 grade level will write a song with Charlie. The preschool and pre-k will each have two classroom visits from Mr. Maguire for some musical fun. Mark your calendars for 6:30 PM on March 16th because the K-8 will be performing their original songs in the St. Charles gymnasium. This is the real deal parents! Please make this event a priority. I do love when we can include our pre-k and preschoolers in events like this, but it takes a LOT of work to get them ready for a performance. After a discussion with the preschool teachers, we decided that the two regularly scheduled performances per year is our limit.

Basketball season is coming to an end, and floor hockey season is beginning at St. Charles. Floor hockey is just a short season, but it is a very cherished and beloved tradition as I've learned over my years here. Soon after spring break, our gym will be pinging with the sounds of baseball and softball bats until the snow melts and they can move practice outside.

Speaking of spring, we're about 3 weeks away from spring break, and the 2nd trimester ends on March 17th, the day before spring break.

Ash Wednesday was a great day for a school Mass and a great beginning to the season of Lent. We're always surprised when we see Ash Wednesday is here, but we're ready for a season where we detach ourselves from many of our comforts. Parish Mission ~ February 25/26-March 1

All are invited to the Parish Mission. A parish mission is an opportunity to renew our commitment to the Lord and to grow in our understanding and love for Christ and the Church. Coming as it is at the beginning of Lent, it is a particular time to enter more deeply into the great mystery of God's profound love for us and participate in the gift of His mercy, especially as He comes to us through the Holy Eucharist.

The mission will be given by a priest of the Society of our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity, Fr. Sam Medley, who is a native son of the Archdiocese. He will preach at all the Masses of the 1st Sunday of Lent, and then give the mission talks Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday evenings in the church, along with an opportunity for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Confession. Each evening talk will be preceded by a community meal and time for fellowship. This is a privileged time for us as a parish to grow in our discipleship of Jesus and prepare for the great Feast of the Resurrection at Easter. Parish Mission flyer.
