Please join us for the St. Charles School Marathon. We will celebrate our service, fundraising efforts and offer reflection and praise to God!

#### **MARATHON GOAL**

- The Marathon is the most important school fundraising event of the year.
- All donations go directly to our school's operating budget to support various programs.

 The Marathon is also a community-building event that helps raise awareness of Catholic education.

#### **FUNDRAISING**

- We are asking each student in Kindergarten through 8th grade to meet a minimum fundraising goal of \$190
- Students in preschool and pre-kindergarten are also invited to participate but are not required.
- Students may ask relatives, neighbors, friends and co-workers to sponsor them for participating. Families may also choose to make the fair share payment of \$190 per student.
- Matching Funds Programs are offered for educational institutions by many companies. They can be a *huge* help in reaching our goal. Please check with your employer about any matching fund programs that may be offered.



#### SERVICE PROJECT

The service projects are always a huge success! Together, our families can donate thousands of hours showing the community the impact of the Charger's spirit. We invite our families to participate in a project this year. This can be a meaningful activity for students to participate in and gather Marathon pledges.

#### **Project Specifics:**

- The service project needs to be completed before the Marathon day.
- The school will not lead, monitor or pre-approve service projects.
- Please wear your SPIRIT WEAR or anything GREEN to show your Charger Pride during your service project.
- Take a photo of your work and send it to Angela Johnson (ajohnson@stchbs.org).
- Service project photos may be displayed on St. Charles School facebook page.
- All service project participants will be eligible for a SPECIAL DRAWING at the closing ceremony of our Marathon!
- Service projects may include:
  - Crafting cards for isolated or elderly people
  - Raking leaves
  - Washing cars
  - Making lunches / boxing food for homeless shelters or those in need
  - Create your own!



#### PRIZES & INCENTIVES:

In addition to supporting our school through fundraising, all students <u>have a chance</u> to win prizes and earn incentives. Prize drawings will be held every Friday up until the Marathon day.

#### **EVERYONE**

• All students preschool through 8th grade will be entered into weekly prize drawings for their efforts in working towards the school goal.

#### **INDIVIDUAL**

- Students who have been selected to read their jokes on marathon day- get a prize!
- Students who have collected \$190 or more by October 13th, will be entered into drawings for grand prizes which will be given out at the marathon closing ceremony during the school day on Tuesday, October 17th.
- Students who <u>participate</u> in the Marathon on Saturday, October 7th, will receive a ticket to be entered into a drawing for one bike gift certificate for CARS Bike Shop. This will be drawn on the day of the Marathon at the end of the festivities.

#### **CLASSROOM**

- The classrooms who meet their class financial goal will earn a popcorn party, a movie, and an out of uniform pass.
- The classrooms who have 100% participation in meeting their classroom goal will earn an extra recess.



#### PRAYER INTENTIONS

Prayer intention slips are for anyone to fill out. These voluntary slips are included in the packet.

- Prayer intentions slips can be turned into the <u>school office</u> at any time before the Marathon day.
- A donation is NOT required for a prayer intention slip to be filled out.
- These intentions may be read on the Marathon day during the family rosary and/or placed before the Blessed Sacrament during adoration.



#### TURNING IN DONATIONS

<u>Please do not turn in donations to the school office until **ALL** of your donations have been collected.</u> If you are donating through TADS or online, you do not need to return the sponsor log or envelope.
