Dear St. Charles Parents,

The first thing on my mind today is the Marathon money deadline tomorrow! Marathon Day was probably the best attended Marathon since I've been at St. Charles. Thank you for making it a great day! Many of us parents wait until the deadline; let's just not miss it! Our goal of \$60,000 is within striking distance. As of this morning our total was at \$51,016, tomorrow is the last day that the money turned in counts toward the incentives and prizes for the kids (we won't stop accepting money). Our closing Marathon ceremony will be Tuesday, October 17 at 10:30 AM in the gymnasium.

Next week, we have a short week for students, and what I call a short/full week for the faculty. Conferences are on Monday and Tuesday from 3:30 PM-8:00 PM after the students leave. If you have not signed up, please follow the link provided below in this Weekly Update.

After a lot of discussion, we are trying a new company to run our school pictures. The company is called Slow Road Photo. Most of their photographers own their own photography businesses but are available during the school day. We believe that this change will result in better quality school pictures. Ordering pictures will be different and will probably be completely online. There will be a Picture Day, a Make-Up Day for those not here on Picture Day, AND a Retake Day. Slow Road Photo will be in contact with you via emails. Picture Day is late this year on Thursday, October 26, with Make-Up Day on Friday, November 3. Retake Day will be December 6th. We are looking forward to picture day – watch for more information!

On October 27, after Mass, we will have an all-school rosary procession, October is the month of the rosary! Around 9:15, we'll gather in the parking lot and make our way around the campus together, stopping at 5 points to pray a decade of the rosary. We'll be led by Fr. Pryzibilla, 3 altar servers, and the 8th graders who will be carrying our statue of Mary. As part of the preparation for receiving their sacraments, our 2nd graders do the planning for this procession with the help of their teachers. You are invited to join us!

When our new playground went in, our basketball hoop had to come down. We are making plans to put it back up and are seeking the help of our construction-handy parents!
