Dear St. Charles Parents,

Our Marathon has wrapped up for the season, and I would like to thank our committee: Julie Neumann, Kysa Hubbard, Sarah Gideo, and Bridget Polsfus! These ladies once again pulled off a successful and fun Marathon! Thank you also to the Knights of Columbus for cooking for us and to all the volunteers who came out Marathon day to be of service. Finally, thank you to you, parents and students, for your efforts fundraising, doing service projects, and sending up prayers for our community. We raised \$56,700 for this year's Marathon! We fell just short of our goal of raising \$60,000. This is still a very successful Marathon. The proceeds from the Marathon go toward operating expenses of the school which help to offset tuition for our families.

Tomorrow we will have our rosary procession after Mass – we estimate starting around 9:15 AM. We will be praying the rosary and processing around the campus. We will begin and end in the lower parking lot/playground. All you need to do is show up and follow along. Bring your rosary for the procession, but you'll be fine even if you don't have it. We will be praying for our parish and school community, and in a special way, lifting up our students and staff members who have passed into eternal life. Please join us for Mass, the rosary, or both if you can.

On November 1st, our church celebrates All Saints Day. Our students will attend Mass at 8:00 AM, and the first graders will process in dressed as some of the most well-known saints. If you have never been there when our 1st grade saints go marching in, it is certainly a thing to see. Please join us if you are able. All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation for us.

On October 31st, our 8th grade volleyball team, currently undefeated, will be facing their tallest task yet, the St. Charles faculty/staff team. This has been a fun and great tradition for our students and staff for years, and a great way to end a day when the kids are already excited.

November 3rd begins the Eucharistic Days celebration in the St. Charles community. There will be 40 hours of perpetual Adoration in the church beginning Friday after the 8:00 AM Mass. Throughout the weekend there are events including a talk by Fr. Brian Park on Saturday evening. The celebration ends with a great gathering after the 10:00 AM Mass on Sunday.
