Please note that our K-4 Advent Prayer Service will be at 6:30 PM on December 12th this year in the church. The Middle School Christmas Band and Choir Concert is on December 14th and will begin at 6:30 PM in the school gymnasium! Being in the gymnasium means we have one big concert instead of two separate concerts. This concert is an important part of your student's band or choir grade. We hope to see all parents and plenty of grandparents. Please have plans for young children during the show and don't let them run amok in the gym entry corridor and concession area (or in the gym please). I will be looking for some audience participation to assist with the taking down of the risers after the choir concert to clear the stage for the band to play!

As you can imagine this is a heartbreaking loss for Aleric and his family. We as a staff have been praying for healing and comfort for the families and friends of these dear souls.
