Dear Charger Parents,

Enrollment season is here, and if you have not enrolled your children for next year, I suggest you do that today. If you get this done by Tuesday, January 16th at 11:59 PM you will be entered in a drawing for three \$100 tuition vouchers for next year!

I have a topic related to enrollment that our pastor Fr. Przybilla asked me to bring to you. When you enroll, you'll notice that there is tuition for parishioners and tuition for non-parishioners. There is not a huge difference between the two, but the difference is an acknowledgment of the support we receive from our parishioners through the parish. The parish provides the school with financial support each year to offset the cost of tuition by covering maintenance costs to the tune of about \$325,000. They do this because they believe in the work we are doing, our mission, and making a Catholic education available to all who desire it. Our parishioners financially support

the parish through weekly offerings, and the parish support comes to the school. This is the reason for the difference in tuition rates.

What does it mean to be a parishioner? If you are selecting the St. Charles parishioner rate, it means that you are a registered member of the parish, attend Sunday Mass regularly, and participate in the Sacramental life of the church. It also means that you contribute to the parish through weekly offerings or tithing, support parish life by volunteering when you are able, and participating in events. I'm clarifying this because the selection of parishioner tuition is on each family's honor, and I want you to know what it means to select this option with integrity. Please contact me or our pastor with any questions on this topic.

In the week ahead, we will have Kindergarten Round Up on Tuesday, January 16, and Preschool Parent Information Night on Tuesday, January 23. There are details in the Weekly Update below, and if you have a child who is eligible for one of these grade levels, you received an email about it. Please share these events with your friends and family who may have an interest in St. Charles School.

As the temperature drops, Chargers continue to go out for recess so long as the temp and wind chill stay above zero, please send your kids to school dressed for the weather. Tomorrow is a great day to go to work and school with your boots on!

There will be exciting news in the weeks to come with Learning Fest and Catholic Schools Week approaching.
