Dear St. Charles Parents,

This past week, we were blessed with a visit from two representatives from the non-profit organization called, "All Belong." This is the organization I mentioned that helps Christ-centered schools serve students who have varied ability levels and special needs. I think we do a commendable job serving these students at St. Charles. This visit from All Belong is the beginning of an effort to see what more is possible in this realm for our school.

Monday, March 4th, is a staff workshop day. We will finalize report cards, work on curriculum alignment, and receive training from "The Catalyst Approach" on student behavior management strategies. Report cards will go home with students on Tuesday, March 5th. Please check backpacks after school!

Floor hockey begins next week after school. Make sure you have your stick taped up and permission slips turned in. K-4 have spectator permission slips, and grades 5-8 have participant permission slips. Please enforce the importance of good behavior and sportsmanship to all of the students. This great St. Charles tradition relies on the cooperation and respect that we teach our students. As a reminder, there IS NO CELL PHONE USE ALLOWED ON CAMPUS. Our "No Phone Zone" is in effect for floor hockey and this includes ALL internet-able devices.

During floor hockey, please make sure you observe the supervision policy in the spectator permission form and have a plan to come and pick up your child, both spectators and players, by 4:30 PM at the latest. Park in the lot, and walk into the gym to locate your child. We are still in need of volunteers for the concession stand and have no fear if you have never done it before. Just sign up for a slot, and everything will work out: <u>concessions sign-up</u>.

Students in grades 5-8 will have the opportunity to go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday, March 5th, during the school day. Students in grades 2-4 will have this opportunity on March 6th. Please help your children prepare for this sacrament; the teachers will be doing the same here at school.
