Conferences are Tuesday, April 9, from 3:30 PM to 8:00 PM and Wednesday, April 10, from 10:30 AM - 4:00 PM

To schedule conferences visit http://www.ptcfast.com/schools/St_Charles_Borrromeo_School. This link will bring you to the St. Charles School scheduling page. Select relevant preschool, elementary teacher(s), and/or a middle school time slot, and then register your name and contact info. This creates a registration for each conference and sends you a confirmation email with a link to choose appointment times.

- Preschool conferences will be scheduled in 15 minutes time slots with your child's teacher.
- Grade K-4 conferences will be scheduled in 20 minute time slots with your child's teacher.
- For Middle School conferences, you will register for one-hour slots. During your hour, you may visit any middle school teacher in any order. If the line is long for a teacher, you may choose to visit another while the line shortens. Please introduce yourself and let each teacher know your child's name when you sit down. Middle school grade-level teacher lists will be provided in the cafeteria on conference nights.
