Each student in Kindergarten through 8th grade is asked to meet a minimum fundraising goal of \$200. Our total school goal is \$60,000.

HOW CAN STUDENTS REACH THEIR \$200 GOAL?

- Ask family, friends, neighbors, and coworkers to sponsor you.
- Host a lemonade stand, bake sale, or candy sale.
- Turn service into fundraising by completing an incentivized service project.
- Share your WeShare donation link by text, email, or social media.
- Ask your parent's employer if they offer matching gifts.
- Families can also make a full or partial contribution toward the \$200 goal.

HOW TO TURN IN DONATIONS:

- Use the school provided donation envelopes and write your child's name and amount.
- Scan the QR code. Share with family, friends and neighbors via social media, email or text.
