

Parent Information Night ~ September 24th!

***Please note:** 5th Grade is a middle school grade but for the purposes of this evening, they will be with K-4.*

Parent Information Night is a chance for you to come and see how your students' classrooms work. You will find out about classroom management, grading, homework, and other practices unique to your child's classroom or grade. You will also find out about your child's teacher, what to do if your child is struggling, a little about the curriculum, and more.

6:30-6:50 - K-5 Session 1 in classrooms (for parents with 2 or more children in grades K-5)

7:00-7:20 - K-5 Session 2 in classrooms (for parents with 1 child in grades K-5 or parents who are coming as a team and splitting up for the presentations to cover 2 grades)

7:30-7:55 - All-School K-8 Session in the cafeteria (for ALL K-8 parents)

8:00 - 8:45- Middle School Session in the cafeteria (for all middle school parents grades 6-8)

Elementary (K-5) Portion of the Evening

The evening will begin at 6:30 PM for K-5 parents only. There will be grade-level presentations from the teachers from 6:30 PM to 6:50 PM and then a repeat of the same presentations beginning at 7:00 PM until 7:20 PM. We do this for families who have more than one child in grades K-5. If you only have one child in K-5, you only need to arrive for the 7:00 PM presentation.

Kindergarten - 8th Grade Portion of the Evening

At 7:30 PM, I will be leading an all-school presentation in the school cafeteria; this will go until about 7:55 PM. Parents who do not have middle school students may depart after the all-school presentation.

Middle School Portion of the Evening

At 7:55 PM, we will break for about 5 minutes, and then the middle school team will take over presenting to the middle school parents in the cafeteria at 8:00 PM. We hope to have this evening complete before 8:45 PM.

For parents with multiple children in elementary and middle school, this is a long evening, but it is an important one. We are laying the groundwork for the year ahead, and we are asking for your partnership by being with us for the evening!
